BY RAIL:

Warwick Station is only half a mile from our Festival site, so getting to us on foot or by bus or taxi is easy. There are direct services from Leamington Spa, London, Banbury and Birmingham. **Leamington Spa Station** is a little further away, but it's still only a 2-mile hop by bus or taxi to the Festival site – or you can even take the connecting train to Warwick! Direct services from London, Oxford, Brighton, Poole, Scotland, Manchester, Liverpool and Birmingham.

BY AIR:

Our nearest airport is Birmingham International, just a few miles up the road from Warwick. Heathrow is the nearest London airport, about 1 ½ hours away by road.
