



Recycling Service - Information for Public

Local environmental organisation Action 21 is providing a recycling service at the Warwick Folk Festival. We do this to divert the recyclable waste generated at the event from landfill. This leaflet provides information about where, when and how you can dispose of the waste you generate.

<p><u>Cans, glass and plastic bottles</u></p> <p>We provide recycling banks around the site for cans, glass and plastic bottles and encourage you to dispose of small amounts of recyclable waste in these banks during the event.</p> <p>If you have a large quantity of any type of recyclable waste please bring it directly to the Action 21 station.</p> <p>Plastic cups are not recyclable at this festival unfortunately and go in general rubbish</p>	<p><u>Cardboard and Paper</u></p> <p>Please flatten your clean cardboard and paper (newspapers, flyers, packaging etc) and take it directly to the Action 21 station where there will be bins for cardboard and paper.</p> <p>Cardboard cups and plates are 'contaminated' once used for food and cannot be recycled. These have to go in general rubbish unfortunately.</p>
<p><u>Compostable waste</u></p> <p>This includes food waste (raw and cooked meat and vegetables, tea bags, coffee grounds, bread, processed food etc)</p> <p>Unfortunately this doesn't include oil or liquid fat or any food packaging</p> <p>We will provide traders with composting facilities. There will some facilities for the public to use.</p>	<p><u>General Rubbish</u></p> <p>At the end of the festival – any non recyclables should be put into your black bin liner and taken to the SKIP at the EXIT of the festival grounds.</p> <p>Please do not leave it on site.</p>

All of the Action 21 people you see at this event are volunteers and are helping out because they'd like to prevent all of the waste from this event going to landfill. Please support them by being as co-operative as possible and following the guidelines above.
