WARWICK FOLK FESTIVAL 2023- INFORMATION FOR CAMPERS

CAMP WITHIN THE DESIGNATED AREAS AND FOLLOW THE STEWARDS INSTRUCTIONS.

In order to comply with local fire regulations we are obliged to maintain clear roadways and not allow camping units to be sited too close together. In case of emergency or incident note where about you are on the site map found in the programme and around the festival village..

The site closes at MID-DAY on Monday 31st July

This is our second time at this new site. Do not climb any fences or wander outside the designated festival area or on to the farm. Do not consider swimming or going near the river, it is deep and dangerous. Our continued use of this site is dependent on your good behaviour.

If you wish to reserve camping space for groups use the Woodside field and not in the Riverside field where the marquee and ceilidh tent are.

Bin bags can be collected from the information tent.

FIRE SAFETY

Establish the location of your nearest Fire-Point where you will find fire extinguishers. These should not be moved except in case of fire. **Barbeques** must be raised off the ground at least by 18 inches so as to prevent fire risk and the disposable ones are not allowed at all. **It is advised that all campers should have a full water bucket by them** or their extinguisher readily available if they have one.

Never use a fuel burning appliance inside your tent or awning, even a cooling barbecue can be lethal.

No open fires allowed anywhere.

At night security guards will patrol the field. The proliferation of theft at festivals means we should be on our guard.

WET WEATHER

In the event of wet weather the movement of cars on and off the field will stop. Note that festival staff working vehicles may still be moving.

A First Aid post will be on site.

SMOKING/VAPING is not permitted in any of the venues and should be kept to the designated areas or your own camping unit. All used items are to be disposed of in appropriate containers as they can be harmful to livestock and other animals if discarded on the ground.

THE CHEMICAL TOILET DISPOSAL POINT is located near the showers. Do not use the drinking water taps to rinse cassettes.

Showers and toilets as on the map and will be open until the campsite closes.

CHILDREN

Parents are responsible for their children at all times whilst they are on the festival site. **Under 10's must always be accompanied by an adult.** If a child is lost or found please inform a steward at the nearest venue.

NO DOGS - except assistance dogs, are allowed on the campsite or venues.

NOISE

Please keep noise level to a minimum, especially at night. Late night singing is only permitted in the designated venues.

PERSONAL GENERATORS are not permitted for campers or traders.

PERSONAL SAFETY

To avoid injury from tripping over tent pegs or guy ropes etc., please keep to marked clearways and do not walk between tents – especially at night.

CLEARING UP

You are camping on agricultural land, forgotten tent-pegs and broken glass could cause injury to animals Please avoid the use of glassware on this site.

SAFTY ON SITE 5mph SPEED LIMIT

Be aware that large vehicles may be moving around the site. Keep out of their way and make sure children are aware of the dangers.

Please deposit your black bags in the skips provided. Sorry we cannot recycle this year. If you wish to, please take your recycling home.

Directors/Management Team/Venue Managers, volunteer stewards and Technical Staff will have badges to identify them.
